# A Joyeful Noyse

The Murray Conservatorium Choir and occasional Orchestra, led by The Moodemere Quartet, invite you to join us in making a 'Joyeful Noyse' at our Christmas celebration!

Honouring historic and contemporary repertoire, this program features a festive selection to appeal to all.

Antonio Vivaldi's Gloria, for choir, orchestra and soloists, is the composer's most famous choral masterpiece for good reason. Lively, elegant Baroque music reflects a text that rejoices in 'God in the highest', asking for mercy and avowing belief in the Holy Trinity. Solos will be performed by Colleen Arnott and Margaret Phillips.

A Gaelic Christmas by local musical legend John Ross, for choir and piano, beautifully sets traditional Gaelic texts from the Western islands and highlands of Scotland in English translation. The words present the Christmas story with a distinctly Scottish flavour and a hint of Druidry in their reverence for the natural world.

Gustav Holst's Brook Green Suite for string orchestra, will be performed 'chamber style' and led by violinist Damien Jones. Holst's signature suggestion of English folk-song prevails in each of the three movements.

Our joyful Christmas concert will be interspersed with a selection of well loved Christmas Carols, led by choir and orchestra, for all to join in.
